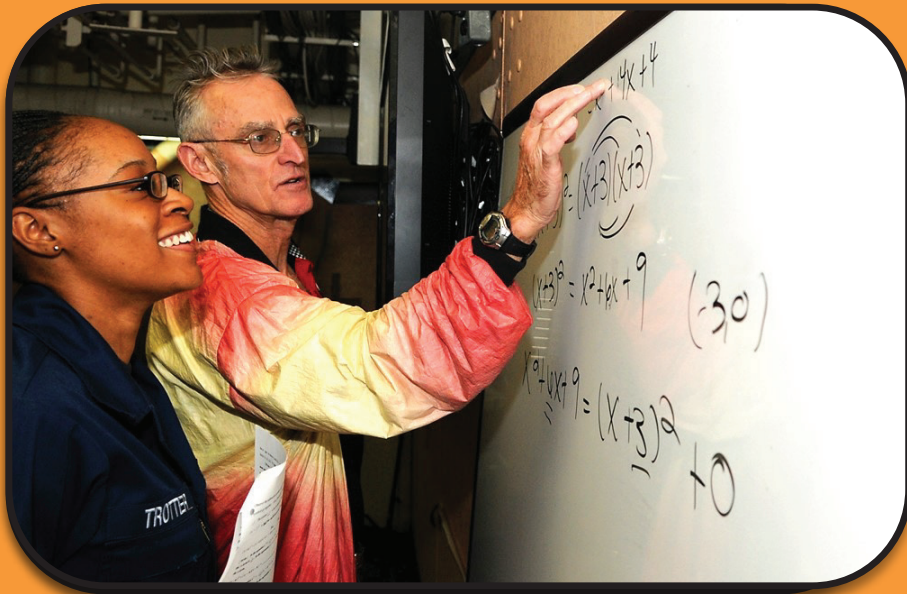




2-Year Degree



Possible Careers

You can pursue careers such as a(n) Cybersecurity Professional, Automotive Technician, Law Enforcement Officer. You can also transfer to a 4-year college.

What is it?

A 2-year degree, or Associate's Degree, requires the completion of at least 60 credit hours, most commonly at a community college. Most students pursue an Associate of Arts (A.A.) or Associate of Science (A.S.).

- Placement Test (*Accuplacer* or *Internal*)
- Financial Aid (FAFSA, DC-TAG & Scholarships)
- Personal Statement
- Letters of Recommendation
- Final High School Transcript
