# ADVANCED INTERNSHIP PROGRAM (AIP)

Registration for **employers** is **now open** for the  
2025-26 school year Advanced Internship Program (AIP).

The Advanced Internship Program is the District's first school-year internship that places highly qualified high school juniors and seniors into opportunities that are specifically aligned to their CTE programs of study and provides students both a wage and course credit. All students have completed at least two Career and Technical Education courses in the industry where they are being placed and are now interested in gaining work experience.

Participating employers have the opportunity to work with Career and Technical Education (CTE) scholars with growing knowledge and experience in their respective programs of study. As an employer, you have the opportunity to:

- Provide meaningful work experience to a future employee of the DC workforce.
- Provide effective leadership experience for your employee.
- Increase production and efficiency at any worksite in your organization.

Interns are paid \$17 per hour at no cost to host employers, and work 8 – 12 hours per week.
